


DISTRACTION CARD THEFT:

Bank branches on KINGSBURY HIGH ROAD and QUEENSBURY have informed us that the cash points are targeted <u>daily</u>. Groups will attempt to distract you; look over you shoulder for the pin and steal the card.

In many cases, cash is withdrawn from your account in minutes:

PREVENTION:

- Use the Cash Machines inside where possible
- Shield your pin and be aware of your surroundings
- If anyone approaches you, put your card away, leave the area and contact the police on 101.
- Cancel your card as soon as you realize something is wrong













LOCAL INFROMA|TION NEEDED:


Queensbury Neighborhood team need information from you. You are our eyes and ears; without you we are unable to tackle crime effectively.

GOOD NEWS

1. Queensbury SNT have successfully closed down a brothel in BERKELEY ROAD, KINGSBURY which has been blighting the quality of life for the local residents

Working with a local resident and the private landlord, we have removed a tenant form the property, closing the brothel within two weeks of the initial visit. A subsequent investigation is ongoing and where possible charges will be brought against those who were in charge.

Feedback from an affected neighbour: "...landlord is now looking for new tenants. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your team for the brilliant job you have done. Honestly I am ever so grateful."

2. CCTV is now active in the WARREN WAY ESTATE and SCOTT ROAD HA8. Anti-social behavior will be targeted and CCTV will be used to identify suspects.
